Scope

Educational Significance

- 1-This project aims at developing the intelligence of the right hemisphere of the brain.
- 2-It aims to develop all the necessary skills and talent related to script-writing, acting editing, cinematography and production.
- 3-It aims to develop aesthetic, moral, social and spiritual values by encouraging students to make meaningful short films.
- 4-it aims to develop the creative and thinking skills of the students.
- 5-It aims to provide a platform to convey the meaningful, inspirational and constructive ideas and messages to the society.

Modus Operandi

Short Films Academy of India is set up in the schools in the similar fashion as the Robotics, Animation, Vedic Math, Dramatics, Dance and Music classes are held in the schools. Only two periods in a week are to be allotted as an option for the visual and performing arts to the students who opt for it by paying a particular fee for the course. There will be enrolment of batches for different durations in a year. The size of a batch will comprise 20-25 students for each category classes 6-8, 9-10 and 11-12] After the completion of the course, students will be awarded certificates

After the completion of the training, deserving and short listed candidates will be given exposure in the short films to be produced under the banner of Talent Club of India. Each year, there will be a Short Film Festival in which the best talent in the field of direction, script -writing, acting, editing, and cinematography will be given due recognition.
